<p>Dress Code Policy(Options)- Vote Staff Response</p> <p>Option 1: Uniforms Option 2: AISD's dress code but with edits specifically for Harris Option 3: AISD</p>	<p>-----</p> <p>The district is likely getting rid of multiple portables. There are benefits to getting rid of them, but there are logistical issues like not having enough bathrooms in the buildings.</p> <p>Question from Ms. Cordova: Will there be more bathrooms with more kids being in the building when they get rid of the portables?</p> <p>Answer is that it may go onto the next bond, but that won't happen any time soon.</p> <p>-----</p> <p>Reviewed responses from staff from dress code survey. 40% said option 2 40% said follow AISD and 20% said keep the uniforms.</p> <p>CAC voted not to keep the uniforms</p> <p>Discussed whether to do option 2 or whether to go with AISD</p> <p>Reviewed Option 2 & determined no changes needed to be made.</p> <p>CAC Voted between Options 2 & 3</p> <p>Option 2 -- an edited version of AISD's dress code won after a vote. Shaleiah, Rudy, and Ms. King were called to have their votes included.</p> <p>-----</p>	<p>Syed</p>
<p>Budget for 2021-22 year- Vote</p>	<p>-----</p> <p>We are at \$60,000 less in the budget this year. Partly because of enrollment, partly because the state isn't releasing the money.</p> <p>Our enrollment went up 14 kids after Operation Reconnect.</p>	<p>Cardenas</p>

<p>Review Mission and Vision- Vote</p>	<p>May 22nd will do another door-to-door campaign & leave door hangars.</p> <p>We have 160 students registered for next year. The culture of the school is that parents wait until August. But that means we can't appeal for more teachers (which we think we'll need).</p> <p>Ms. Neunabor asked about families at Mueller Flats. We learned that Harris families were evicted because the building was condemned. 18 Harris students total were affected.</p> <p>-----</p> <p>Mission & Vision brainstorm.
