Came up with strategies that will help inform tutoring. <p>Shaleiah: How is this data used by the district?</p> <p>Ms. Cardenas: Used as a growth tool to measure whether we've improved.</p> <p>TELL Survey</p> <p>Ms Cardenas shared that Ms. Cordoba suggested reviewing the survey and doing a self-reflection around what we're doing prior to taking the TELL survey. Especially this year -- the pandemic has been very isolating. Ms. Olivares gave good feedback too that "don't know" is not an option for teachers on the survey.</p> <p>There were suggestions to share the positive info from the survey on the website and Dojo.</p> <p>Dress Code Survey Results:</p> <p>We got a lot more results because of sending home a paper version of the survey.</p> <p>Majority said to keep it the same</p> <p>15% said to edit</p> <p>30% said follow the district</p> <p>Many said if we do uniforms the school should provide them.</p>	
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	<p>Ms. Wyatt suggested posting anywhere the school uniform is on sale, also help from Operation School Bell, also clothing swaps. Also provide them to</p> <p>Shaleiah: hesitate to vote as a new parent because want to be respectful of the wishes of the parents at the school.</p> <p>Alice: Can we add leggings/comfortable pants? Can we add T-shirts (in addition to polos). With a goal of making compliance easier.</p> <p>Shaleiah: Concerned about editing the dress code when many families voted on the dress code as it was.</p> <p>On suggestion of Ms. Syed, we voted to present new options, get feedback from teachers and staff and then vote on Dress Code in May.</p> <p>Ms Cordova: Some of the parents who filled out the paper survey but “keep it the same” because this year there’s no dress code and they want to keep it that way.</p>
